their obligations have been cleared**

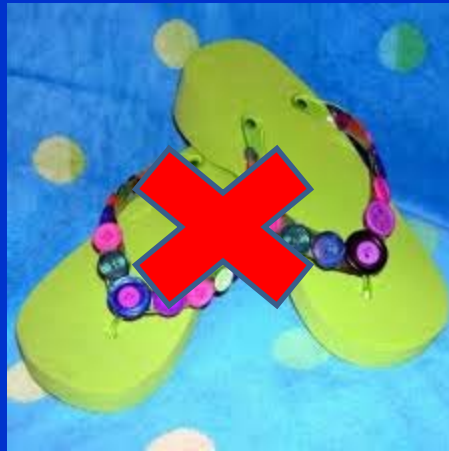

Important Dates For Seniors

- **Graduation Practice**
 - Friday June 1st & Monday June 4th, 2012 from 7:30 – 10:15 AM. Seniors report to Auditorium and must be on time; Cooperation & Behavior of potential graduates will determine if there is a 2nd practice on Monday
 - Tickets given out after practice if all obligations are cleared (dues, fees, parking tickets, etc.)
 - Graduation practice is mandatory for all seniors

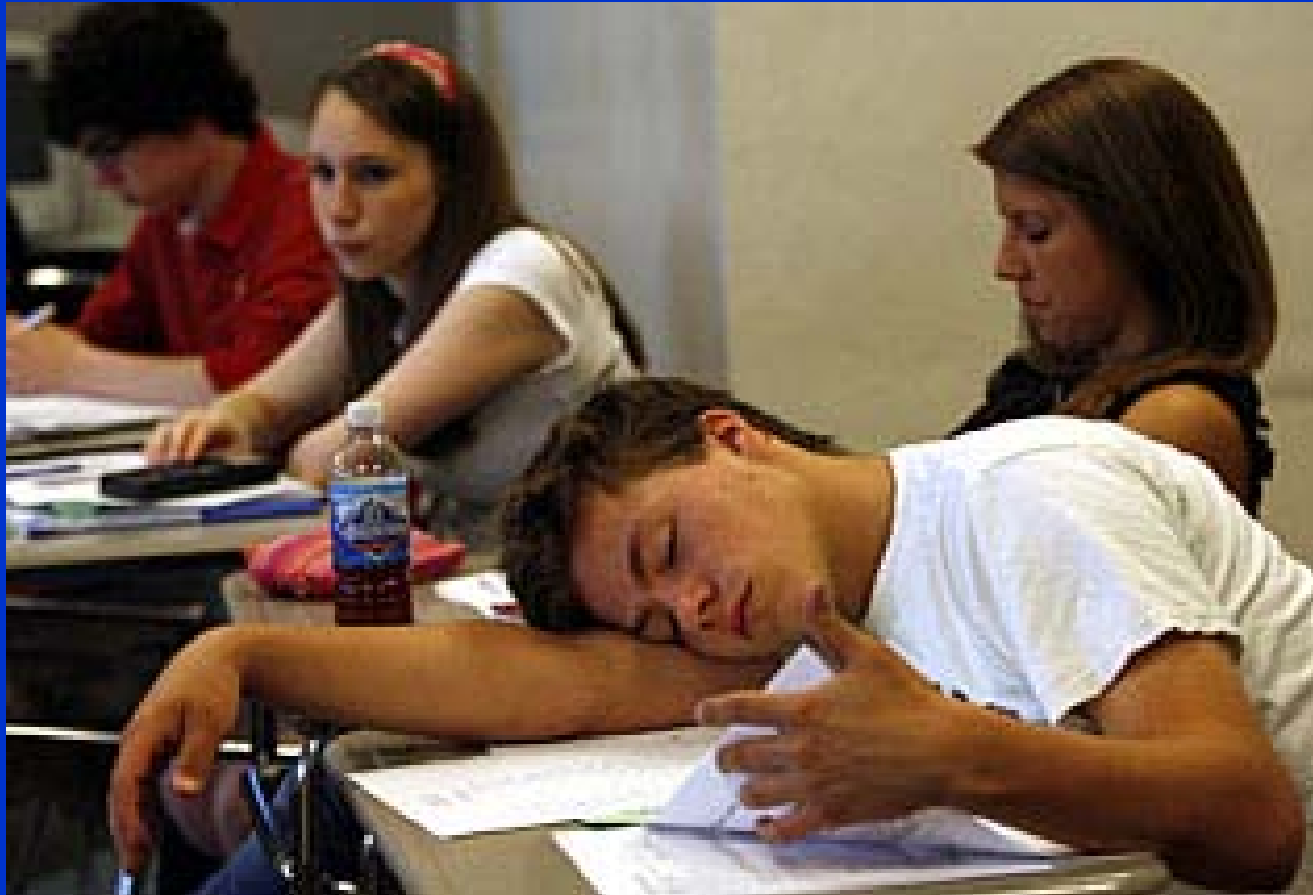
Important Dates For Seniors

Board of Education Policy

- **Participation in Senior Activities:** Graduating students who violate Board policies on possession, consumption, or distribution of alcoholic beverages, controlled dangerous substances, counterfeit controlled dangerous substances, non-controlled substances, or other intoxicants, at any time during the last four weeks of school prior to the last scheduled day for graduating students, or during the time between the last scheduled day and the graduation ceremony, whether the activity takes place on school buses, within a school building or upon any school property, or during any school, school related, or Board-sponsored activity, whether held on school property or at locations off school property, including private clubs, businesses, or commercial establishments, shall be prohibited from participation in all senior activities, including proms, award ceremonies, and graduation ceremonies. Other disruptive behavior by senior students during the last four weeks of school will jeopardize the privilege of participating in graduation ceremonies.
