

## **Preschool Program at Old Mill High School**

A preschool program is an integral part of the high school course, Child Development. The fall preschool curriculum is designed for children who are three and one-half and four years old. (Three-year-old children must be three by May 1, 2011. Children registering for the program should have a birth date between September 2, 2006 and May 1, 2008.) High school child development students along with the teacher teach preschoolers both group and free choice activities, which are based on weekly themes. Program objectives for the preschool children include providing a variety of activities to promote physical, emotional, social, and intellectual development as well as promoting school readiness for kindergarten. The fall semester program is scheduled to begin the last week of October and continue through the middle of January. The morning session meets three days a week from 7:30 to 10:15 a.m., while the afternoon session meets three days a week altering from 12:45 p.m. to 1:55 p.m. on one day and 11:15 a.m. to 1:55 p.m. on the next day.
