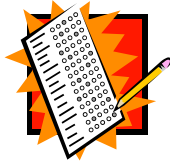

Graduation Practice

Dates: Friday, June 1st and Monday, June 4th

Graduation practices will be held from 7:30 am to 10:30 am. All graduating seniors must be in the auditorium by 7:30am. **Cooperation of graduating seniors at June 1st practice will determine the necessity for 2nd practice on Monday June 4th.** Practices will be held as necessary to ensure a dignified graduation ceremony for all students and guests. Seniors will receive **8 graduation tickets** following the final rehearsal. **All obligations must be cleared prior to receiving tickets. Attendance at graduation practice is mandatory. Students must participate in graduation rehearsal to participate in the graduation ceremony. Obligations: Seniors must have cleared all obligations prior to graduation rehearsal. This includes textbooks, class dues, media center obligations, fines, etc... Graduation tickets will not be issued until all obligations are satisfied**

Alcohol, Drugs, and Other Incidents for Seniors

Participation in Senior Activities:

Graduating students who violate Board policies on possession, consumption, or distribution of alcoholic beverages, controlled dangerous substances, counterfeit controlled dangerous substances, non-controlled substances, or other intoxicants, at any time during the last four weeks of school prior to the last scheduled day for graduating students, or during the time between the last scheduled day and the graduation ceremony, whether the activity takes place on school buses, within a school building or upon school property, or during any school, school related, or Board-sponsored activity, whether held on school property or at locations off school property, including private clubs, businesses, or commercial establishments, shall be prohibited from participation in all senior activities, including proms, award ceremonies, and graduation ceremonies. Other disruptive behavior by senior students during the last four weeks of school will jeopardize the privilege of participating in senior activities including graduation ceremonies.

Graduation Ceremony

When: Tuesday, June 5th, 2012 @ 7:00 P.M.

Where: Prince George's Equestrian Center & Show Place Arena, Upper Marlboro

Graduates should arrive at 5:30 P.M. and report to the tunnel area. Please allow plenty of time for commuting to the Arena on Tuesday evening. Traffic can be delayed as much as an hour.

Attire: Graduation is a dignified ceremony. Students must be dressed appropriately. Ladies should wear white or light pastel dresses and low-heeled dress shoes. Gentlemen should wear a dress shirt, tie, dress pants, and dress shoes. Tennis shoes and flip flops are not permitted.

Caps and Gowns: Seniors must purchase a 2012 cap and gown to participate in the ceremony. Caps and gowns, graduation announcements, and senior items are provided by Jostens. Contact Mrs. McQueary (C202) or Mrs. Wilson-Bernard (B114) to order.

Accessible Seating and Parking: Limited handicapped parking spaces are available. If special accommodations are necessary, please contact Mrs. Perry (Principal's secretary) at the school.

Diplomas: Seniors will receive their diploma cover when they walk across the stage. After the ceremony, seniors will recess to the back of the arena into the tunnel and will report to the appropriate alpha ordered table to receive their diploma.

Photography: A photographer has been contracted to take each graduate's picture during ceremony. No one else will be permitted to stand near the stage or on the floor of the arena to take pictures.
